ANTENNA PRODUCTS CORPORATION AWARDED CONTRACT

PHAZAR CORP announced today that Antenna Products Corporation in Mineral Wells, Texas, a wholly owned subsidiary, was recently awarded a \$6,227,008 contract from BAE SYSTEMS ATI for the production of 132 crossed dipole antennas plus the antenna support structures and ground screen items. This equipment will be manufactured at Antenna Product Corporation's plant in Mineral Wells, Texas and is scheduled to be delivered in approximately 15 months. The equipment will be shipped to the High Frequency Active Auroral Research Program (HAARP) ionospheric research site near Gokona, Alaska, the site of the Development Prototype array of 48 crossed dipole antennas built by Antenna Products Corporation in 1994.

As the result of this order, Antenna Products Corporation's backlog of orders as of April 17, 2003 was approximately \$8.4 million.
